John F. (Jack) Schlegel Endowed Leadership Scholarship

This scholarship is presented to a pharmacy student recognized for the potential of exceptional leadership in the profession after graduation through exemplary behaviors and actions as a student and professional in training

My name is Janet Nhan, and I am currently doing my rotations. I went through the candidacy process for the Alpha Psi chapter in Spring 2017.
