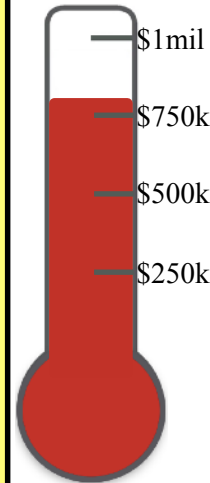
## Recap: Leadership 102

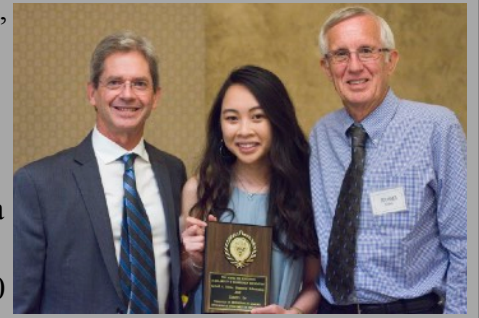
Dr. Kristen Lau '19 was the recipient of the **MAX Scholarship**.
