



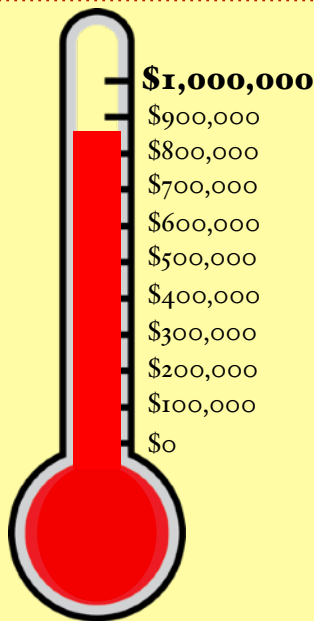

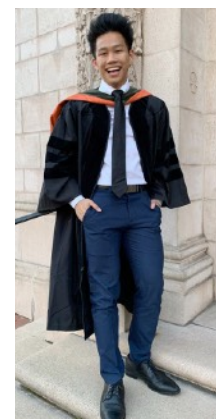
Recap: Leadership 301 New Practitioners

Kristen Ward '17 and Annie Ho '12 hosted our first New Practitioner's webinar on 6/27/2020. It was a 90 min program that drew in 30 participants throughout the call. The 1st half was presented by Chase Armer and Daryl Wong, certified financial planners. They discussed retirement accounts and money management/budgeting, followed by a presentation about student loans and the PSLF (public service loan forgiveness program) by Bess Glinka, Cynric Cho, and Annie. Each section was followed by Q&A. 8 participants answered the feedback poll, providing a score of 4.125/5 for value and 100% would recommend this to their peers. Feedback was overall positive, pointing out that the programming was informative and useful. Areas for improvement include diving deeper into less topics and coming up with more questions to engage the audience during the discussion portion.
