



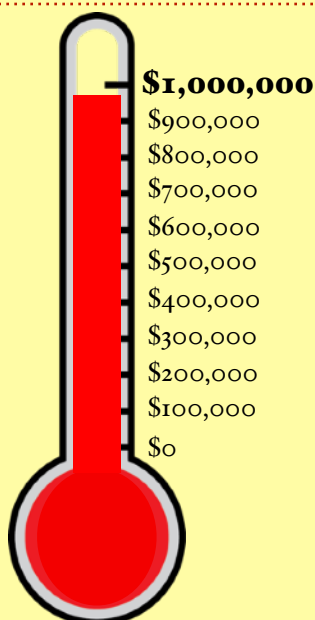

On Tuesday, December 1st, National Giving Day, the Alpha Psi Foundation participated with over 60 non-profit organizations in San Joaquin County, in a 24-hour giving day. This day raised **\$12,670** from 29 donors, including alumni brothers, Foundation Directors, and Committee Chairs. Out of 65 participating agencies, the Foundation raised the 3rd highest amount.
