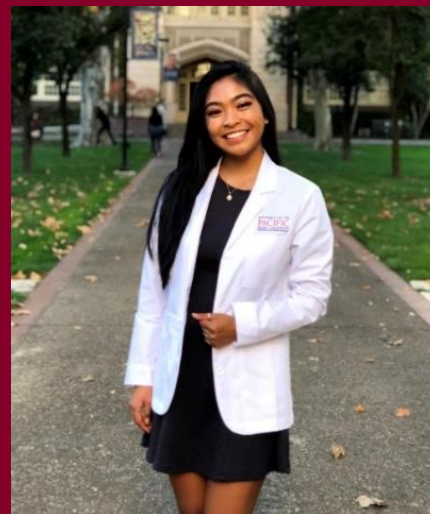


John F. (Jack) Schlegel Endowed Leadership Scholarship Recipient 2021
