



## <u>Powell Match Gift Agreement:</u> <u>Alpha Psi Foundation Endowed Scholarship</u>

We are overjoyed to share the announcement of this major event for the Alpha Psi Foundation history. On December 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2022, the Powell Match Gift Agreement between the Alpha Psi Education, Scholarship & Leadership Foundation and University of Pacific Thomas J. Long School of Pharmacy was established.

The Alpha Psi Foundation has made an irrevocable donation of \$100,000 to be matched by the Powell Fund Match, a gift matching program of the University of the Pacific. This agreement will create a \$200,000 endowment to provide \$8000 annually in new student scholarships for School of Pharmacy students who are members of the Alpha Psi Chapter of Phi Delta Chi. The scholarships will primarily provide support for Pre-Pharmacy, 1st and 2nd year students. As a result of this agreement, the Foundation will be providing approximately \$20,000 annually in scholarships in addition to our Leadership programs and grants.
