This \$1,500 scholarship was established in 1965 to recognize the new initiate with the highest cumulative grade point average (GPA).

Highlights from Foundation Annual Meeting:

- Board approval to increase the **E.E. Roscoe Memorial Scholarship, Ivan W. Rowland Memorial Scholarship, MAX Scholarship, Gerald A. Miller Memorial Scholarship, and Rick Friedmann Memorial Scholarship** each by \$500 for a total increase of \$2,500 yearly.
- The **Mills donation** was an incredible \$100k to our Foundation. This donation will be placed into our **Collegiate Conference Travel Fund** which is geared toward support for national and regional conferences.
- The **Brother of the Year award** is a new award this year hosted by the Brothers of Alpha Psi. The Foundation has agreed to fund \$500 in scholarship for this award.
